BUKIT MERTA JAM - Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) Daerah Seberang Perai Tengah sedang mengesan ibu kandung dan waris kanak-kanak lelaki bernama Muhammad Qhasbie Abdulah berusia lapan tahun yang menjadi mangsa pengabaian ibu kandungnya.

Pelindung Kanak-Kanak Pejabat Kebajikan Masyarakat Daerah Seberang Perai Tengah, Siti Nur Fazlina Md Daud, berkata ibu kandung yang dikenali sebagai Nur Syazfana mula menghilangkan diri sejak April 2024.

Menurutnya, kanak-kanak itu kini berada di Tempat Selamat JKM.

"Kanak-kanak telah diselamatkan oleh JKM pada September 2023 di bawah Seksyen 25(2) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2021.

"Hasil dapatan pelindung didapati kanak-kanak tidak memiliki siji kelahiran memandangkan ibu kandung tidak pernah mendaftarkan kelahiran kanak-kanak di Jabatan Pendaftaran Negara," katanya ketika dihubungi Sinar Harian, di sini pada Jumaat.

Siti Nur Fazlina berkata, pihaknya cuba menghubungi ibu kandung kanak-kanak berkenaan namun gagal memandangkan wanita itu tidak mempunyai alamat yang tetap serta tiada nombor telefon untuk dihubungi.

Jelasnya, permohonan Pengecualian Seksyen 15(3) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 telah diluluskan untuk siaran media.

Waris atau orang ramai yang mengenali ibu kandung kanak-kanak terbabit boleh menghubungi Pelindung Kanak-Kanak Daerah Seberang Perai Tengah di talian 04-538 2584.

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Bar calls for tabling of Senior Citizens Bill to protect ageing population



Malaysia is at a critical juncture in the demographic shift towards an ageing population.

Malaysia's Department of Statistics projects that the percentage of citizens aged 65 and above will rise from 8.6% in 2019 to 14.5% by 2040, placing unprecedented demands on the nation's care system.

This demographic transformation presents Malaysia with an urgent and important opportunity to establish a holistic and comprehensive legal and policy framework that will guarantee the protection, welfare and dignity of its senior citizens for generations to come.

The current retirement financial preparedness of Malaysians presents significant challenges that require the immediate attention of our legislative and policy makers.

According to the Employees' Provident Fund (EPF), 91% of the 44-year-old members have less than RM100,000 in their savings – below the RM140,000 needed to secure a modest monthly income of RM1,000 for 20 years post-retirement.

This financial gap, combined with rising caregiving costs, underscores the importance of establishing robust legal protection and support systems to ensure elderly Malaysians can age with dignity, security and quality of life.

We thus welcome and applaud the government's efforts to look into increasing the retirement age from 60 to 65, allowing senior individuals who are keen and capable to continue their valuable contributions to the workforce.

The Malaysian Bar recognises the significant effort and work undertaken by the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development in developing the Senior Citizens Bill, as a measure to aid seniors.

We understand that comprehensive legislation requires careful consultation and thorough preparation. Therefore, we welcomed the ministry's reported progress on the Senior Citizens Bill, aimed at ensuring protection for Malaysia's ageing population, and we hope that our following analysis will be considered in the final draft of the bill.

The Malaysian Bar requests the government to incorporate a holistic, rights-based framework within the final draft of the bill, ensuring proactive and legally enforceable protection for our senior citizens through the following core provisions:

- **Codified rights and protections:** Senior citizens must be legally guaranteed the right to healthcare, shelter, safety, financial protection and dignity – rights that are enforceable by law. This framework would align with the UN's *Principles for Older Persons*, which also reflects Malaysia's commitment to human rights.
- **Accountability for neglect and abuse:** The bill must include robust legal mechanisms to address emotional, physical and financial elder abuse. Proper support for victims and rehabilitative options for families must be incorporated into the framework.
- **Oversight through a statutory council:** Establish a national commission for senior citizens or a similar oversight regulator to oversee the implementation of the bill and ensure compliance with other relevant laws or policies, and represent the voices of senior citizens in policymaking.
- **Comprehensive community and care support:** Prioritise home-based and community care by ensuring access to trained caregivers and providing financial support for families caring for elderly dependents.
- **Access to legal aid and financial support:** Provide senior citizens with dedicated legal aid for wills, disputes and protection from exploitation, alongside fair pensions and financial assistance to secure their welfare.

- **Mandatory regulation of care homes:** All aged care facilities must be licensed, audited and held accountable for the treatment and welfare of their residents. Minimum standards for aged-regulated older care centres and all nursing homes, with minimums including more than one registered facilities. Regulation and licensing are critical to ensuring the safety and dignity of seniors residing in these institutions.

- **Mental health and social inclusion:** Address the challenges of isolation, depression and dementia through a holistic mental health review and community support programmes.

Malaysia has an excellent opportunity to leverage 'positive ageing' – technology specifically designed for the senior citizens – to enhance independent living, improve mental health and support families with caregiving responsibilities. We can learn from the successful implementation of elderly care in Singapore and Japan, and harness the opportunity to develop innovation and creative solutions, such as wearable health devices, telehealth services and smart home systems, while ensuring these remain a facilitator and protect data privacy.

The Malaysian Bar reiterates that the rights and welfare of seniors must remain an integral part of legislation informed by international best practices. Jurisdictions such as Canada and South Korea have demonstrated that a statutory framework for senior citizens' welfare can be transformative, not just in providing protection for the elderly, but also in fostering dignity and inclusion.

For instance, the Canadian Government provides comprehensive support for its senior population, offering income security programmes, initiatives designed to keep seniors active and engaged, whilst their communities, and reliable assistance to help them remain in their own homes.

Such frameworks look at all inclusive long-term care insurance systems designed to ensure the wellbeing of older people experiencing physical, mental or cognitive conditions, while simultaneously alleviating the caregiving burden borne by their families.

The Malaysian Bar calls on the government to continue building on the promising progress already made and look forward to the successful completion and tabling of this transformative legislation.

A truly effective Senior Citizens Bill must include the most voices of insight, above a robust legislative framework based on our ageing population.

The Malaysian Bar stands ready to contribute its legal expertise and insights to ensure that the legislation is effective and efficiently enacted, for the benefit of all Malaysians. — Bar

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We Need To Expedite The Action Plan For The National Children's Policy — Dr Amar-Singh HSS Et Al

Currently, the National Children's Policy is just a well-meaning concept on paper. We are long overdue in taking concerted action to change the situation.



The updated National Children's Policy was launched in November 2024, but we are still waiting to see the planned deliverables, namely the promised action plan to accompany this policy.

The National Children's Policy focuses on the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) key aspects of survival, protection, development, and participation, including aspects of health, education, safety, and welfare.

These are all vital areas in the lives of many children in Malaysia, especially those who need protection from abuse and harm, those living in poverty, children with disabilities, and those without access to health care, education, and an identity.

We understand that the Ministry of Women, Family and Community Development (KPWKM) has recently presented an idea of the action plan to relevant agencies and civil society organisations.

The plan focuses on merging programmes targeted at parents, the integration of capacity development, and advocacy and awareness programmes among various ministries.

KPWKM highlighted the four main objectives (survival, protection, development, and participation) and the 10 strategic priorities, and indicated that it will be monitored under the Majlis Kebangsaan Bagi Hal-eh Kanan (MKBKK) under the auspices of the Social Welfare Department (DKH).

Sadly, we are again left wondering what actions will be taken, when, and to what end. The presentation lacked any meaningful deliverables.

What mechanisms and resources will be used to achieve these strategic priorities? Which agencies will be involved and who will take responsibility for each strategic priority? What is the timeline to achieve each strategic priority?

It is important to look at the timelines for the development of our National Children's Policy:

- 2009-2015: We have a National Children's Policy and the National Children's Action Plan, but there has not been any published evidence-based data on the effectiveness of the policy and plan. We are unsure whether an independent external audit was conducted and made public, or how the current National Child Policy is aligned with the Regional Plan of Action to promote children's rights and protection and meet the Sustainable Development Goals Malaysia is committed to. We also have a National Child Protection Policy and action plan for the time period with the same concerns.
- 2020: Planning to upgrade the National Children's Policy and action plan involving relevant ministries and agencies.
- 2021-2022: Development of the National Children's Policy.
- 2023: Final draft of policy was distributed to relevant ministries and agencies for feedback and approved by National Children's Policy Development Steering Committee and Action Plan meeting.
- June 2024: Cabinet approval of the National Children's Policy.
- November 2024: Revised National Children's Policy launched (no action plan).
- April 2025: KPWKM presented an idea of the action plan to relevant agencies and civil society organisations (no detailed action plan).

It is of concern that after close to five years, we still do not have access to or a clear idea of the action plans, indicators, targets, and timelines that will be put in place to improve the lives of all our children.

Will targets meet the international standards, laws, and policies such as the UNCRC, CEDAW, and SDGs, and improve the lives of our children?

While KPWKM has engaged civil society organisations (CSOs) and the private sector, their engagement with families and communities has been limited and not far-reaching, leaving many grassroots organisations that champion the rights and protection of children nationwide out of the ecosystem.

As the National Children's Policy states in the last page, "Children's rights are our shared responsibility." It would be best if KPWKM share their existing or draft action plan they have online, and engage CSOs involved with children, professionals, and children to help strengthen the action plan for the next five years.

It would be ideal to make the action plan of the National Children's Policy a living document with shared responsibilities among CSOs and the general public. A living or dynamic document can be continually updated and revised to ensure it remains current and relevant.

It would also allow for action plans to be implemented immediately and monitored collectively using an all-of-society approach. It would encourage us to listen to children and decide their involvement in the plans and decisions that affect their lives.

We need to systematically ensure that diverse and marginalised children, including stateless children, refugee children, undocumented children, indigenous children, and children with disabilities participate in the formation of the action plan. We need to ensure that it is child-friendly, age, gender, and linguistically appropriate, and that disabled-friendly versions of the policy and action plan are made accessible for all children and young Malaysians.

As a civil society, we would like to see targets and indicators that focus on:

- Halving the child poverty rate by 2030 for all children, regardless of their legal status, in line with Sustainable Development Goals (SDG 1).
- Urgent institutional and policy reforms to implement a mandatory universal education access policy for all children regardless of their legal status (SDG 4).
- Enactment of legal provisions that guarantee all children living in Malaysia the right and access to health care, regardless of their legal status, in line with the Convention on the Rights of the Child (Article 24), and Child Act 2001 (SDG 3).
- Reducing and ending all forms of violence, abuse, exploitation, and trafficking of children (SDG 16.2).
- Ending the stateless status of children in Malaysia by 2030 (SDG 16).
- Bridging the gaps in gender inequality (SDG 5).
- Ending child marriage by 2030 (SDG 5).
- Supporting and protecting the mental and psychosocial health of children and young people (SDG 3).
- Increasing budgetary allocations for children's services that reflect current needs.

In addition, we require the formation of an independent child rights committee that monitors and evaluates the progress made by the National Children's Policy and its action plan.

Currently, the National Children's Policy is just a well-meaning concept on paper. We are long overdue in taking concerted action to change the situation. Our children desperately need our action yesterday.

HARI Ibu bukan sekadar sambutan simbolik, sebaliknya pengiktirafan peranan besar kaum ibu dalam membentuk keluarga dan masyarakat.

Pengerusi Lembaga Penduduk dan Pembangunan Keluarga Negara (LPPKN) Sarawak, Datuk Seri Rohani Abdul Karim berkata, jasa ibu tidak terhingga dan perlu dihargai setiap masa, bukan hanya setahun sekali.

"Di Sarawak, kita lihat pelbagai latar belakang dan kisah ibu luar biasa.

"Meraka semuanya memiliki persamaan iaitu membesarkan anak walaupun berdepan cabaran," katanya.

Rohani berkata demikian ketika merasmikan Sambutan Hari Ibu Peringkat Negeri Sarawak 2025 di Galeri Pustaka Negeri Sarawak Kuching baru-baru ini.

Bertemakan Sentuhan Kasih Ibu, sambutan kali ini turut disertai dengan pelbagai pengisian seperti Bicara Santiahi Wanita, Ibu dan Masa Depan Negara, saringan kesihatan dan pameran agensi.

Tambah Rohani, tekanan-tekanan yang dihadapi para ibu masa kini termasuklah kos sara hidup, tuntutan kerja, masalah kewangan dan kurang masa untuk diri sendiri.

"Laporan Tinjauan Hari Ibu 2024 (meliputi seluruh Malaysia) mendapati sembilan daripada 10 ibu merasakan tanggungjawab mereka hari ini jauh lebih mencabar berbanding dahulu.

"Lebih membimbangkan, 32.2 peratus ibu dilaporkan mengalami kemurungan, manakala 5.6 peratus pernah berfikir untuk mencederakan diri sendiri. Ini bukan angka kosong.

"Ini isyarat jelas bahawa para ibu perlukan sokongan menyeluruh," katanya.

Jelasnya, pelbagai usaha dilaksanakan kerajaan melalui Dasar Wanita Negara 2025-2030 serta program di bawah Kementerian Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Masyarakat (KPWKM) termasuk PROKIT, IKIT, MamaCare dan Wanita Bangkit.

"LPPKN juga giat melaksanakan saringan kesihatan seperti Ujian Mamogram serta Saringan Kanser Serviks (HPV DNA) dan mamogram bersubsidi, selain kempen kesedaran kanser reproduktif wanita (WCaRe).

"Hingga 20 Mei 2025, seramai 43,166 wanita Sarawak telah menjalani ujian HPV DNA, manakala 17,862 menerima ujian mamogram di bawah program LPPKN," ujarnya.

Dalam pada itu, Rohani turut memaklumkan kerajaan memperuntukkan RM6 juta di bawah Belanjawan 2025 untuk Program Bantuan Rawatan Kesuburan dan Advokasi Infertiliti (BuAI) bagi membantu pasangan mendapatkan zuriat.

Rohani berharap Sambutan Hari Ibu Peringkat Negeri Sarawak 2025 memberi manfaat kepada semua terutama para ibu dan wanita. Pada masa sama, Rohani juga menyeru semua pihak dapat bersama-sama menghargai ibu bukan sahaja pada hari seperti ini tetapi juga pada setiap harinya.

Pada program Sambutan Hari Ibu Peringkat Negeri Sarawak itu, lebih 300 orang wanita dan ibu dari pelbagai agensi, kelab dan pertubuhan dari serata negeri hadir.

Dalam majlis sama juga, Dayang Azzah Mohd. Salih diumumkan sebagai penerima Anugerah Inspiroi Ibu 2025 atas sumbangan luar biasa beliau sebagai pendidik, ibu dan pemimpin masyarakat.

GEORGE TOWN, 6 Jun (Bernama) — Kerajaan negeri menjemput lebih ramai usahawan wanita termasuk ibu tunggal yang menjadi pencari nafkah utama keluarga untuk mendaftar sebagai peserta Penang Women Entrepreneurs Mentoring Programme 2025 atau PenMentor2025 sebelum 31 Julai ini.

Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Pembangunan Sosial, Kebaikan dan Hal Ehwal Bukan Islam negeri Um Siow Khim berkata inisiatif itu bagi membantu wanita memperoleh ilmu perniagaan sekaligus mengembangkan perniagaan mereka menerusi program khas oleh Perbadanan Pembangunan Wanita Pulau Pinang (PPWDC) dalam usaha membolehkan wanita mencapai kejayaan dalam bidang keusahawanan.

PenMentor satu program yang menyatukan latihan intensif, bimbingan mentor dan peluang rangkaian untuk usahawan wanita. Lebih 350 peserta telah berjaya sejak 2020.

"Tahun lepas kita lihat peningkatan 50 peratus purata jualan selepas menyertai program ini, membuktikan bimbingan yang betul boleh membawa hasil," katanya dalam kenyataan hari ini.

Berlaku PenMentor yang dilaksanakan buat tahun keenam itu juga akan membantu usahawan wanita selak digital bergerak dengan rentak gelombang ekonomi masa kini dan masa hadapan.

Sementara itu, Ketua Pegawai Eksekutif PPWDC Datuk Ong Bee Leng berkata PenMentor akan berlangsung selama tiga bulan, iaitu dari Ogos hingga Oktober tahun ini dengan merangkumi empat hari kursus intensif keusahawanan dan enam kali bimbingan bersama mentor.

Berlaku berkala program itu dibahagikan kepada tiga kumpulan bahasa, iaitu bahasa Melayu, bahasa Inggeris dan edisi baharu tahun ini dalam bahasa Mandarin dengan anggaran setiap kumpulan mempunyai 25 orang mentee (peserta).

Mentee akan dibahagikan dalam subkumpulan yang mengandungi lapan mentee dan dua mentor. Pembahagian berdasarkan nature of business, iaitu jika perniagaan berasaskan makanan, kita akan kumpulan bersama, jika berasaskan pembuatan, kita akan kumpulan bersama.

"Mentor yang akan dipilih datang daripada pelbagai latar belakang industri dan mempunyai pengalaman lebih kurang lima tahun dalam bidang masing-masing," katanya.

Ong berkata PenMentor tahun ini lebih bertokus kepada topik pemasaran digital dengan modul pemasaran digital akan dikendalikan oleh Digital Penang yang merangkumi subjek TikTok Shop, Canva dan Capcut.

Antara syarat penyertaan program berkenaan ialah peserta merupakan wanita Pulau Pinang, warganegara Malaysia yang berumur 18 tahun dan ke atas serta yuran pendaftaran RM200 bagi kumpulan berpendapatan B40 manakala RM400 bagi kumpulan M40 dan T20.

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Pending rep calls out Welfare Dept over inaction on homeless woman outside Kenyalang supermarket

KUCHING (June 6) Pending assemblywoman Violet Yong has urged the Sarawak Social Welfare Department to take immediate and decisive action to assist a homeless woman who has been squatting outside a supermarket in Kenyalang Park for over a month.

The Democratic Action Party (DAP) lawmaker expressed frustration over the department's lack of follow-through, despite the issue being reported in early May.

"This matter has drawn considerable public concern. Upon receiving complaints in early May, our DAP Kuching Service Team immediately reported the situation to the Social Welfare Department of Sarawak through the proper channels.

"Regrettably, the matter has not been resolved thus far," she said in a statement today.

She revealed that while the department initially responded by engaging with the woman, efforts were later abandoned after officers were unable to contact her family.

She added that the failure to locate family members should not be an excuse for inaction.

"It is deeply irresponsible for the department to leave a vulnerable individual without any form of assistance or shelter, forcing her to continue living in public spaces in a visibly distressed state," Yong said.

Yong said she had formally raised the issue during the Sarawak State Legislative Assembly (DUN) sitting on May 28, appealing for intervention from the Ministry of Women, Childhood and Community Wellbeing Development, iterating that the DAP Kuching Service Team had also lodged a report with the police to further highlight the urgency of the matter.

"Unfortunately, to date, no effective measures have been undertaken by any relevant authority," she said.

Members of the public have continued to report sightings of the woman in the same location, prompting concerns not only for her wellbeing but also for the cleanliness and image of the area, said Yong.

She added that she will continue to follow up the matter with the relevant authorities until action is taken to assist this individual.

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Ibu, kekasih ditahan dera dua anak

Perbuatan pasangan berusia 37 dan 42 tahun terbongkar selepas anak sulung wanita itu berjaya melarikan diri dan meminta bantuan penduduk setempat.

Difahamkan, jawatankuasa penduduk yang menerima aduan itu kemudian melaporkan kepada Jabatan Kebajikan Masyarakat (JKM) dan polis.

Ketua Polis Daerah Subang Jaya, Asisten Komisiner Wan Azlan Wan Mamat berkata, polis menerima laporan daripada pihak JKJ mengenai kejadian itu pada 12.43 tengah hari.

"Hasil siasatan mendapati ibu mangsa dan teman lelakinya tinggal serumah bersama mereka.

"Polis menahan kedua-dua mereka dan ujian saringan air kencing dijalankan mendapati suspek lelaki positif dadah manakala ibu mangsa negatif," katanya dalam kenyataan hari ini.

Selain itu, beliau berkata, semakan mendapati teman lelakinya juga mempunyai lapan rekod lampas berkaitan dadah.

Menurut Wan Azlan, pemeriksaan pihak hospital terhadap kedua-dua mangsa mendapati tiada sebarang kesan kecederaan fizikal atau parut lama pada tubuh mereka.

"Siasatan lanjut mendapati dua beradik itu tidak diberi makan oleh penjaga mereka, walaupun tidak dikurung secara fizikal.

"Dalam masa sama, keadaan kediaman juga didapati kotor dan tidak selamat untuk didiami, selain persekitarannya yang tidak sesuai untuk kanak-kanak.

"Mangsa berusia 16 tahun dilaporkan mengalami tekanan perasaan akibat pengabaian yang berlaku," katanya kedua-dua mangsa masih berada di hospital untuk pemerhatian lanjut.

Kata beliau, kedua-dua suspek kini diroman enam hari bermula semalam sehingga 10 Jun ini untuk siasatan lanjut.

"Setakat ini, kita sudah merakam keterangan lima orang saksi bagi membantu siasatan kes itu," katanya.

Katanya, kes disiasat mengikut Seksyen 31(1)(a) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001 yang membawa hukuman penjara sehingga 20 tahun atau denda maksimum RM50,000 atau kedua-duanya jika sabit kesalahan.

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Tukang jahit mengaku tak bersalah cabul remaja OKU

KUALA LUMPUR: Seorang tukang jahit mengaku tidak bersalah di Mahkamah Sesyen Ampang dekat sini hari ini atas pertuduhan mencabul kehormatan seorang remaja perempuan orang kurang upaya (OKU), bulan lalu.

Tertuduh, Ahmad Nizar Ahmad Aminudin, 25, membuat pengakuan itu selepas pertuduhan terhadapnya dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Nurulizwan Ahmad Zubir.

Mengikut pertuduhan, tertuduh didakwa mencabul kehormatan mangsa yang ketika kejadian berumur 17 tahun, di sebuah tandas di Taman Keramat, di sini pada pukul 6.30 petang, awal Mei lalu.

Pertuduhan dikemukakan mengikut Seksyen 354 Kanun Keseksaan yang membawa hukuman penjara sehingga 10 tahun atau denda atau sebatan, atau mana-mana dua daripada hukuman itu, jika sabit kesalahan.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Norhidayah Abdullah Sani mencadangkan jaminan RM6,000 dengan seorang penjamin dan memohon syarat tambahan iaitu tertuduh dilarang mendekati mangsa serta saksi-saksi pendakwaan memandangkan remaja perempuan berkenaan merupakan OKU kategori Sindrom Kurang Daya Tumpuan dan Hiperaktif (ADHD).

Bagaimanapun, peguam bela Lingwaran Singh yang mewakili Ahmad Nizar memohon jumlah ikat jamin minimum kerana anak guamnya hanya bekerja sebagai tukang jahit dan perlu menanggung keluarga.

Mahkamah kemudian membenarkan tertuduh diikat jamin sebanyak RM4,000 bersama syarat tambahan seperti yang dimohon pihak pendakwaan dan menetapkan 21 Julai depan untuk sebutan semula kes. — UTUSAN

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Lelaki didakwa cabul adik perempuan rakan usia 9 tahun

Seorang lelaki ditahan atas lima tuduhan melakukan amang seksual fizikal terhadap adik perempuan kepada rakannya yang benua berusia sembilan tahun.

MELAKA – Seorang pembantu kedai lelaki didakwa di Mahkamah Sesyen di sini, pada Jumaat, atas lima tuduhan melakukan amang seksual fizikal terhadap adik perempuan kepada rakannya yang benua berusia sembilan tahun.

Terduduh, Ahmad Dzul Fiqar Ahmad Fardzil, 21 tahun, bagaimanapun membuat pengakuan tidak bersalah sebaik kesemua pertuduhan terhadapnya dibacakan di hadapan Hakim Haderiah Siri.

Berdasarkan empat pertuduhan, dia didakwa dengan sengaja melakukan perbuatan bagi maksud seksual di bawah Seksyen 14(a) Akta Kesalahan-Kesalahan Seksual Terhadap Kanak-Kanak 2017 yang boleh dikenakan hukuman sebat, jika sabit kesalahan.

Dia yang masih bujang turut didakwa melakukan perhubungan bertentangan dengan adun tali tanpa persetujuan mangsa, mengikut Seksyen 377C Kanun Keseksian yang memperuntukkan hukuman penjara antara lima hingga 20 tahun dan sebatan, jika sabit kesalahan.

Kesemua kesalahan itu didakwa dilakukan di sebuah rumah pangsa di Ayer Keroh, di sini, antara jam 10 malam hingga 1 pagi, pada 31 Mei lalu.

Timbalan Pendakwa Raya, Wardah Ishtar, mencadangkan jaminan RM20,000 bagi setiap pertuduhan, selain memohon syarat tambahan agar terduduh melapor diri setiap bulan di balai polis berhampiran serta tidak mengganggu mangsa dan saksi pendakwaan sehingga kes selesai.

Peguam Amitpal Singh yang mewakili terduduh menayu jaminan rendah kerana terduduh hanya bekerja sebagai pembantu kedai makan, malah keluarganya tidak berkemampuan untuk membayar wang jaminan yang tinggi.

Setelah mendengar hujah kedua-dua pihak, Hakim Haderiah membenarkan terduduh dijamin RM25,000 bagi semua pertuduhan serta bersetuju dengan syarat tambahan dipohon oleh pihak pendakwaan.

Mahkamah turut menetapkan 8 Julai depan sebagai tarikh sebutan semula kes dan serahan dokumen.

Media pada Isnin lalu melaporkan terduduh yang juga rakan kepada abang mangsa melakukan perkara terukut itu ketika dia datang ke rumah adik-beradik tersebut.

Perbuatan jahatnya itu terbongkar selepas mangsa mencadangkan pertakuan terduduh terhadapnya kepada ibu, sebelum wanita itu bertanya pertika berkenaan kepada lelaki terbabit.

Lelaki itu akhirnya mengaku melakukan perbuatan tersebut sebelum wanita berusia 40-an itu tampil membuat laporan polis.
