## Unacceptable to exploit children for online content, says minister

**PETALING JAYA:** It is unacceptable for anyone to exploit children for online content, says women, family and community development minister Nancy Shukri.

She said this after social media users raised concerns over several posts involving a man and his daughter.

In a post on X, Nancy said she viewed seriously the issue involving a man who was managing his daughter's social media account.

"Even though it is (managed) by parents, such exploitation is improper," she said.

Nancy thanked netizens who reported the matter to the social welfare department and the child development department.

"We will always prioritise the safety and welfare of children," she said.

Several social media users have taken issue with some of the posts that had been uploaded, with some labelling the behaviour as a "red flag".

They also shared screenshots of the content that they deemed inappropriate.

## Govt programme brings services directly to remote Orang Asli villages

**GUA MUSANG:** The Kembara Merdeka Be Ades Ma Kampung programme has delivered essential government services directly to remote Orang Asli communities across three villages.

This collaborative initiative involved the Social Welfare Department, the National Registration Department, and the Ministry of Health working together.

Over one thousand Orang Asli residents from Pos Hau, Pos Belatim, and Pos Balar received assistance through this programme.

Temiar tribe member Anjang Ayeh expressed gratitude for the programme bringing government counter services directly to their villages.

He explained that MOH personnel assessed his daughter Rosmawati Anjang in Kampung Redip and identified her learning disorder.

This diagnosis now enables her to receive monthly welfare assistance from the Social Welfare Department.

Anjang had long awaited this assessment but faced transportation difficulties due to their remote location.

"My daughter appears physically normal, but behaves like a child," he told reporters.

"She only makes friends with those aged seven to ten and struggles to socialise with adults."

Another resident Angah Asang felt relieved after helping his ailing mother replace her identity card.

"It was previously challenging to bring my mother to town due to her condition," he said.

The Chairman of the Orang Asli Village Security and Development Committee expressed gratitude for the government's acknowledgement of rural challenges.

Galas assemblyman Mohd Syahbuddin Hashim emphasised the ongoing focus on ensuring remote communities receive government benefits.

He noted that many Orang Asli find it difficult to travel to towns despite living far from urban centres. – Bernama

## Pembangunan negeri: Perkasa peranan wanita

August 22, 2025



**KUALA TERENGGANU:** Wanita disifatkan sebagai aset penting negeri Terengganu yang bukan sahaja memainkan peranan dalam rumah tangga, malah turut menjadi penggerak ekonomi, tokoh akademik, ahli profesional, pemimpin politik serta penggerak masyarakat.

Setiasaha Kerajaan Negeri, Dato' Nara Setia Dato' Zulkifli Ali berkata, negeri dan negara tidak akan mampu bergerak maju tanpa sumbangan besar golongan wanita.

Menurutnya, penggubalan Dasar Wanita Terengganu lahir daripada suara, aspirasi dan keperluan wanita itu sendiri, dengan matlamat memastikan mereka menikmati peluang sama rata, perlindungan sewajarnya serta ruang luas untuk menyumbang kepada negeri.

"Kalau kita menelusuri sejarah, wanita telah lama memainkan peranan yang besar. Dari tokoh-tokoh wanita dalam sejarah Islam seperti Saidatina Aisyah RA, seorang ilmuan yang unggul.

"(Beliau) mempunyai ketokohan dan disegani membuktikan wanita mampu cemerlang dalam memberikan sumbangan. Di Terengganu sendiri, kita melihat ramai wanita yang berjaya sama ada dalam bidang pendidikan, keusahawanan, seni budaya, mahupun sukan.

"Namun, masih ada ruang untuk kita perbaiki, terutama dalam aspek keterlibatan wanita dalam membuat keputusan di peringkat negeri," katanya ketika merasmikan Seminar Dasar Wanita Terengganu 2025 di sini semalam.

Turut hadir, Timbalan Pengerusi Jawatankuasa Kebajikan, Pembangunan Wanita, Keluarga dan Perpaduan Nasional Negeri, Zuraida Md Noor.

Mengulas lanjut, beliau berkata, masih terdapat cabaran perlu ditangani termasuk aspek ekonomi, kemahiran digital, isu sosial seperti keganasan rumah tangga dan diskriminasi gender, serta keseimbangan kerjaya dengan tanggungjawab keluarga.

Katanya, Pelan Induk Terengganu Sejahtera (PITAS2030) turut memberi penekanan kepada pemartabatan wanita berasaskan konsep Islam, selain memperkasakan golongan suri rumah melalui aktiviti sosial, keagamaan dan ekonomi.

Dasar berkenaan akan digerakkan melalui 18 skop utama merangkumi agama, keluarga, keperluan asasi dan infrastruktur, keselamatan, kesihatan, hak dan undang-undang, sistem sokongan, ekonomi, kepimpinan dan politik.

Juga kesukarelawanan dan masyarakat, golongan rentan dan minoriti, jaringan, alam sekitar, teknologi maklumat, alam sekitar, kesenian, sukan dan pekerjaan.

Beliau berkata, seminar itu tidak seharusnya sekadar menjadi medan perbincangan, sebaliknya mesti diterjemah kepada tindakan konkrit oleh jabatan, agensi dan pihak berkepentingan.

"Saya menyeru agar kerajaan, NGO, ahli akademik dan masyarakat berganding bahu menjayakan agenda ini. Kefahaman dan kerjasama, sokongan dan dokongan oleh semua.

"(Usaha) melaksanakan Dasar Wanita Terengganu adalah amat penting demi kesejahteraan masyarakat dan ummah," katanya. – HARAKAHDAILY 22/8/2025

## Witnesses can now report bullying cases via MyHELP

**PETALING JAYA:** Even witnesses can report bullying cases in the Health Ministry through the MyHELP portal.

According to the Management of Bullying in the Workplace guidelines launched on Thursday, the witness can record the details of the incident, including the date, time, location, perpetrator and the victim involved.

Witnesses must be willing to cooperate by providing statements and evidence gathered to support the victim's report.

However, they are advised not to take matters into their own hands and act against the perpetrator in a way that could worsen the situation.

Aside from that, the victim must also lodge a complaint via the MyHELP portal.

It will take the integrity unit up to 15 working days to resolve complaints that are classified under the common category.

For cases under the complex category, it can take a minimum of 16 working days to resolve.

Counselling services will also be provided to the victim for emotional and mental well-being.

Complaints on bullying cases can also be submitted through various channels, including the Public Complaints Management System, e-mail, official letters, complaint boxes, face-to-face (walk-in) complaints, and via mass media platforms.

Doctors, meanwhile, said their only concern is the protection of

whistleblowers' identities.

A medical officer in Kuala Lumpur said many are afraid to report bullying cases out of fear that the perpetrator will find out.

“There was a case of verbal abuse where, when the perpetrator found out that a complaint was lodged against him, he began to give the victim a hard time,” the doctor, who spoke on condition of anonymity, claimed.

“The superior was always verbally abusing her to a point that she was depressed. Somehow, it reached the superior when a

complaint was lodged.

“So we want the ministry to ensure that our identities are protected and the investigation is fair and just,” he said.

Another doctor in Penang, echoed the same sentiment, adding that the culture of seniors bullying juniors to “toughen” them up is quite common.

“They often say that they were treated that way so we too must go through it. We want protection and clear guidelines on what constitutes bullying and what does not,” he said.

Malaysian Medical Association (MMA) president Datuk Dr Kalwinder Singh Khaira welcomed the guidelines.

He said the initiative came into fruition after repeated calls on the need to foster safe and respectful working environments for healthcare workers.

“We hope these guidelines will not only provide clear procedures for reporting and handling cases, but will also bring about real change on the ground.

“The well-being of healthcare

workers must remain a priority, as it directly impacts the quality of care delivered to patients,” he said in a statement yesterday.

“At the same time, we wish to stress the importance of ensuring closure for cases of bullying that have already been reported.

“The MMA has, in the past, brought up cases to the attention of the Health Ministry, including a case in Sabah. For healthcare workers to have confidence in the system, it is vital that complaints are not only addressed with urgency, transparency and fairness, but also bring about closure for all affected.

“We trust that with these new guidelines in place, such cases will be resolved swiftly and that this initiative will mark the beginning of a stronger, zero-tolerance culture against bullying in our healthcare services,” he added.

The guidelines, developed by the National Centre of Excellence for Mental Health, outline a new workplace culture within the ministry that is more empathetic, professional and supportive.

## Group proposes anti-bullying measures

**GEORGE TOWN:** Bullying in Malaysian schools is far more rampant than official figures suggest, said the Penang Hindu Association (PHA).

Its president Datuk P. Murugiah said bullying has grown more widespread and severe, with new cases surfacing almost every week in the media.

"We see bullying as a severe social problem that has an unfavourable impact on student development and behaviour.

"Recently reported cases show victims being subjected to persistent physical force, emotional abuse and psychological intimidation meant to injure, threaten and dominate," he said in a statement.

Murugiah said bullying, although not new, has intensified in recent years with technology and social media fuelling its spread.

He said the effectiveness of measures such as circulars, guidelines and posters issued by the Education Ministry must be reviewed.

Murugiah also raised concerns over the role of school counsellors, hostel wardens,

student affairs officers and heads of institutions, saying they should be more proactive in monitoring and intervening before cases escalate.

He added that the consequences of being bullied could be devastating, with victims often withdrawing socially, suffering low self-esteem and, in some cases, developing suicidal thoughts if their trauma is left unaddressed.

To combat the problem, PHA called for wider awareness of the legal consequences of bullying under the "Esha Clause" (Section 507D), and suggested introducing a subject similar to Civics to address bullying, sexual harassment and mental health through open class discussions.

It also urged the government to:

- increase the number of school counsellors;
- install helpline phones connecting students directly to the Education Ministry anti-bullying unit or police;
- ensure hotline numbers are prominently displayed in schools; and
- allocate more funds for the installation and upkeep of closed-circuit television cameras, including in private schools.

He added that the current WhatsApp

hotline for complaints related to bullying is 014-800 9325.

Murugiah further recommended regular talks by police officers on bullying and gangsterism, and stressed that any attempt by school officials to cover up cases must be dealt with firmly.

"When school administrators are given incentives for zero-bullying, they might not report bullying cases," he told *theSun*.

He also reminded parents to communicate more with their children to detect early warning signs of bullying.

"Often, bullying cases go unrecognised until an extreme consequence occurs. As such, school-based monitoring and interventions need to be effectively implemented."

Murugiah said the fight against bullying requires cooperation between all stakeholders – the Education Ministry, law enforcement, school authorities, counsellors, teachers and parents.

"With such cases on the increase, we need to act now and act together because the pain of a bullied teenager is very real.

"Educational institutions must once again be seen as places of learning, connection and security."

JOHOR BAHRU : Murid Tahun Empat yang menjadi mangsa buli dalam dua insiden berasingan di sebuah sekolah agama dan sekolah kebangsaan di Skudai di sini, mula menunjukkan keterujaan untuk kembali ke sekolah.

Ibu kepada Izzul Islam Azuan Isaidi, Siti Suhana Misd, 40, berkata walaupun masih trauma, anak keempat daripada enam beradik itu menyatakan tidak sabar untuk berjumpa dengan dua kawan baiknya.

"Izzul masih belum ke sekolah kerana cuti sakit sehingga bulan depan. Tetapi, dia memang teruja nak pergi sekolah sebab nak jumpa dua kawan baik dia.

"Mereka bertiga memang baik. Bila kena buli pun, kawan dia ni la yang bantu dan lindung dia. Dia takut tapi sebab ada kawan, dia 'okay'. Izzul memang seorang yang ceria, suka senyum dan suka berkawan," katanya ketika ditemui di rumahnya di Taman Universiti, Skudai di sini, hari ini.

Siti Suhana berkata, kesan buli ke atas anaknya, kanak-kanak berusia 10 tahun itu kerap mimpi dan mengigau sehingga boleh tiba-tiba menangis ketika tidur.

"Saya rasa dia masih trauma. Dia kata dia macam nampak hantu. Kejadian buli ini menyebabkan dia suka duduk sendiri, nangis, lepas itu kita tak boleh gurau kasar dengan dia. Dia macam rasa kecil hati, sebab dia sakit, dia tak boleh campur kita," katanya.

Siti Suhana berkata, walaupun keluarga kanak-kanak yang didakwa membuli anaknya itu sudah tampil memohon maaf, namun dia masih membenarkan pihak polis meneruskan siasatan ke atas kes buli itu.

Katanya, dia tidak bercadang untuk menarik balik laporan polis kerana mahu kes itu diselesaikan mengikut lunas undang-undang dan diadili sebaiknya.

"Jabatan Pendidikan Negeri Johor (JPNJ) memang beritahu akan ambil tindakan, tetapi saya belum dimaklumkan perkembangannya. Siasatan polis masih dijalankan," katanya.

Bercerita lanjut, suri rumah itu berkata, Izzul Islam sudah berdepan antara enam hingga lapan kali pembedahan bagi pelbagai jenis masalah kesihatan sejak 2022.

"Anak saya memang ada masalah kesihatan sebelum ini antaranya masalah hidung dan saluran pernafasan yang menyukarkannya bernafas serta susah tidur lena; mata kabur kesan masalah hidungnya selain keluar lendir, nanah dan darah dari hidung.

"Dia juga pernah melakukan pembedahan hernia. Selepas kejadian buli, dia semakin sakit kepala, cepat pening, tidak boleh lasak dan mudah penat," katanya.

Terdahulu, Siti Suhana dan suami, Azuan Isaidi Khairudin, 38, menerima kunjungan Pengurus Besar Pasaraya Econsave Cash and Carry, Mas Imran Adam yang menyampaikan sumbangan keperluan harian berjumlah RM1,000 kepada keluarga itu.

Mas Imran berkata, pihaknya berharap sumbangan disampaikan dapat meringankan beban buat keluarga berkenaan dan mendoakan Izzul Islam segera sembuh.

Sebelum ini, Izzul Islam didakwa menjadi mangsa buli dalam dua kejadian berasingan pada Februari lalu dan awal bulan ini, dekat dua sekolah di negeri ini.

Kanak-kanak itu dilaporkan mengalami masalah gegaran otak akibat kejadian buli berkenaan.

### Babysitter claims trial to causing baby's death

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A 24-year-old babysitter broke down in tears in the dock yesterday after being told she would remain in custody unless she could post bail of RM20,000, following a charge of leaving a 7-month-old baby unattended, which allegedly led to his death in May.

Nor Fatimah Abdul Rahim, dressed in a green *jubah*, was seen weeping as she was comforted by her family members before being handcuffed and escorted out of the courtroom, following proceedings before Sessions Court judge Siti Shakirah Mohtarudin.

She claimed trial to a charge of leaving the infant without making reasonable provision as his babysitter, resulting in the death of Muammar Aidil at 11.08am at a daycare centre in Wangsa Maju on May 26.

The offence, under Section 33(1)(a) of the Child Act, carries a maximum fine of RM20,000 or imprisonment of up to five years, or both, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutor Nidzuwan Abd Latip objected to bail, citing the seriousness of the charge.

The judge then directed Fatimah, who had no legal representation, to make her own plea for bail.

Through tears, she appealed for a lower bail, telling the court she came from a poor family.

"I am supporting my father, who suffers from nerve problems, as well as my mother and a sibling.

"I am also due to get married at the end of this year," she said.

Visibly emotional, she repeatedly turned towards her family seated in the public gallery.

The court granted bail of RM20,000 with one surety and fixed Sept 29 for mention.

Lawyers Fithril Hakim Ab Jalil and Abi Mursyidin Awal held a watching brief on behalf of the victim's family.

In May, Wangsa Maju deputy police chief Superintendent Syahrul Anuar Abdul Wahab said the baby's cause of death was determined to be asphyxiation due to food and milk aspiration.

## Babysitter charged after infant under her care dies

**KUALA LUMPUR:** A babysitter wept hysterically in the dock after claiming trial to a charge of leaving a child under her care unsupervised, which resulted in the death of the infant.

Nor Fatihah Abdul Rahim, 24, could not contain her emotions as she was comforted by her family members after the proceedings ended.

As she was taken away by the police to the lock-up, Nor Fatihah was heard calling out for her mother.

Earlier, she pleaded not guilty after the charge was read out before Sessions Court judge Siti Shakirah Mohtarudin yesterday.

Nor Fatihah was accused of committing the offence, which resulted in the death of the seven-month-old boy, at a nursery in Wangsa Maju on May 26.

The charge, under Section 33 (1) (a) of the Child Act 2001, provides a maximum fine of RM20,000 or a jail term of up to five years or both, if convicted.

Siti Shakirah fixed bail at RM20,000 in one surety.

The case is fixed for mention on Sept 29.

**Tawau:** Tiga belas remaja berusia antara 16 hingga 19 tahun didapati bersalah membunuh pelajar Kolej Vokasional (KV) Lahad Datu, Mohamad Nazmie Azzat Mohd Narul Azwan, pada Mac tahun lalu.

Mereka dituduh bersama-sama membunuh Mohamad Nazmie Azzat, 17, atau dikenali sebagai Ijat, di bilik asrama kolej berkenaan pada jam 9 malam 21 Mac hingga 7.38 pagi 22 Mac tahun lalu.

Hakim Datuk Duncan Sikodol, ketika membacakan keputusan itu di Mahkamah Tinggi, di sini semalam berkata, semua tertuduh didapati bersalah mengikut Seksyen 302 dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 Kanun Keseksamaan.

Dalam penghakimannya, Duncan berkata, berdasarkan penilaian keseluruhan bukti, mahkamah berpuas hati bahawa 13 tertuduh bertindak secara bersama dengan niat bersama hingga menyebabkan kematian mangsa.

Sehubungan itu, katanya pihak pendakwaan berjaya membuktikan kes melampaui keraguan munasabah.

### Hujahan tak berasas

Dalam pada itu katanya, hujahan pembelaan bahawa tertuduh hanya mahu memberi pengajaran kepada mangsa adalah tidak berasas kerana kecederaan yang dialami terbukti cukup parah dan secara semula jadi membawa maut.

"Isunya bukan sama ada tertuduh berniat untuk membunuh, sebaliknya sama ada kecederaan yang disengajakan itu sudah memadai dalam keadaan biasa untuk menyebabkan kematian.

"Bukti perubatan jelas menunjukkan ia memang membara maut," katanya.

Selain itu beliau berkata, alasan provokasi juga tidak terpakai kerana apa yang berlaku

bukan reaksi spontan, sebaliknya serangan berlarutan dan berulang kali.

Beliau turut menolak hujah bahawa mangsa mungkin terselamat sekiranya menerima rawatan segera kerana keterangan pakar hanya menyebut ia satu kemungkinan, bukan kepastian.

Mahkamah menetapkan 28 Ogos ini untuk prosiding hukuman, sementara menunggu laporan ahklak daripada Pegawai Kebajikan Masyarakat mengikut peruntukan Seksyen 90(12) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001.

Pada 15 April lalu, pasukan pembelaan menutup kes selepas memanggil 18 saksi pada perbicaraan peringkat bela diri dengan kesemua 13 remaja terbabit memberi keterangan bersumpah dari kandang saksi.

rakat mengikut peruntukan Seksyen 90(12) Akta Kanak-Kanak 2001.

Seramai 13 remaja berusia 16 hingga 19 tahun dituduh bersama-sama membunuh mangsa di bilik asrama kolej berkenaan pada jam 9 malam 21 Mac hingga 7:38 pagi 22 Mac tahun lalu.

Pada 15 April lalu, pasukan pembelaan menutup kes selepas memanggil 18 saksi pada perbicaraan peringkat bela diri dengan kesemua 13 remaja terabit memberi keterangan bersumpah dari kandung saksi.

Mereka didakwa mengikut Seksyen 302 Kanun Keseksaan (KK) dibaca bersama Seksyen 34 kanun sama yang memperuntukkan hukuman mati atau penjara 30 hingga 40 tahun serta tidak lebih 12 sebatan, jika sabit kesalahan.

Lapan daripada 13 tertuduh diwakili peguam, Kamarudin Mohamad Chinki, Datuk Ram Singh serta Chen Wen Jye, manakala lima tertuduh lagi diwakili peguam Abdul Ghani Zelika dan peguam lantikan, Vivien Thien, Jhasseny P Kang, Kusni Ambotuwo serta Mohamed Zairi Zainal Abidin.

# 13 TEENS FOUND GUILTY OF STUDENT'S MURDER

Judge says defence's argument that accused only wanted to 'teach victim a lesson' is unfounded

**T**HIRTEEN teenagers, aged 16 to 19, have been found guilty of the murder of student Mohamad Nazmie Azzat Mohd Narul Azwan, 17, at the Lahad Datu Vocational College last year.

In delivering the verdict, High Court judge Datuk Duncan Sikodol said the prosecution had proven its case beyond a reasonable doubt.

He ruled that all the accused were guilty under Section 302 of the Penal Code, read together with Section 34.

He said the defence's arguments, including alibis, total denials and partial admissions, were inconsistent with witness testimonies and unreasonable.

He said the defence's argument that the accused only wanted to "teach the victim a lesson" was unfounded because medical evidence proved the injuries were severe enough to cause death.

"The issue is not whether the accused intended to kill, but whether the intentional injury was, in normal circumstances, sufficient to cause death," he said.

"Medical evidence clearly showed that it was indeed fatal."

He said the argument of provocation was not applicable because the attack was prolonged and repeated, not a spontaneous reaction.

He dismissed the defence's argument that the victim might have survived if he had received immediate medical treatment, saying that expert testimony only mentioned this as a possibility,

not a certainty.

The teenagers were charged with murdering Nazmie Azzat at the college's dormitory between 9pm on March 21 and 7.38am on March 22 last year.

The court set Aug 28 for sentencing, pending a behavioural report from a welfare officer.

The defence closed its case on April 15 after calling 18 witnesses, with all 13 accused giving sworn statements.

The teenagers were charged under Section 302 of the Penal Code for murder, which carries a death penalty or a prison sentence of 30 to 40 years, with no more than 12 strokes of the rotan, upon conviction.

Eight of the accused were represented by lawyers Kamarudin Mohamad Chinki, Datuk Ram Singh and Chen Wen Jye, while the other five were represented by Abdul Ghani Zelika and appointed lawyers Vivien Thien, Jhasseny P Kang, Kusni Ambotuwu and Mohamed Zairi Zainal Abidin.

## 13 students found guilty of murdering college mate

**KOTA KINABALU:** Thirteen teenage students of Kolej Vokasional Lahad Datu have been found guilty of murdering their college mate, in a case that has gripped Sabah since last year.

The boys, who were convicted of the murder of Mohamad Nazmie Azzat Mohd Narul Azwan, will only be sentenced on

Aug 23, pending social reports from the Lahad Datu Social Welfare Department.

Tawau High Court judge Justice Duncan Sikodol, in convicting the boys, ruled that the prosecution had proven the cause beyond reasonable doubt. The boys aged between 16 and 19 were found guilty of murdering the victim between 9pm on March 21 and 7.38am on March 22, 2024.

In his judgment, Justice Sikodol

said that the medical evidence showed that the injuries were severe enough to be fatal.

He said he had considered the defence team's argument that the boys did not intend to kill but had only wanted to teach the victim a lesson when they thought he had stolen from one of them.

He said the defence team had also tried using the argument of provocation, but it was deemed "not applicable" by the court as

the attack on Mohamad Nazmie Azzat was repeated and prolonged, not spontaneous.

A total of 18 witnesses were called to testify throughout the trial in November last year.

The 13 students were first charged at the Lahad Datu Magistrate's Court on April 2, 2024, before the case was transferred to the High Court on Aug 13, 2024.

Their trial commenced in November 2024.

## College students **found guilty** of murdering peer

► Sentencing fixed for Aug 28, pending behavioural reports from welfare department

**TAWAU:** The High Court yesterday found 13 Lahad Datu Vocational College male students guilty of causing the death of fellow student Mohamad Nazmie Azzat Mohd Narul Azwan, 17, last year.

Judge Datuk Duncan Sikodol ruled the teenagers guilty under Section 302 of the Penal Code after finding the prosecution had proven the case beyond reasonable doubt.

He fixed Aug 28 for sentencing, pending behavioural reports from the Lahad Datu Social Welfare Department as required under Section 90(12) of the Child Act 2001, Bernama reported.

"At the close of the defence, it is clear that the explanations offered, ranging from total denial, alibi, partial admission and shifting blame to a non-accused student, are either inconsistent with the evidence, contradicted by independent witnesses or inherently improbable.

"Based on the evaluation of the evidence as a whole, the court is satisfied beyond a reasonable doubt that the 13 accused, acting

in concert and sharing a common intention, caused the death of the deceased in circumstances that fall within Section 300(c). The prosecution has discharged its burden."

He said the suggestion by the defence that the accused merely intended to teach the deceased a lesson and did not know the injuries would, in the ordinary course of nature, cause death and therefore fall under Section 299 of the Penal Code, is equally without basis.

He also said under Section 300(c) of the Penal Code, the question was not whether there was an intention to kill, but whether bodily injuries were intentionally inflicted that were sufficient in the ordinary course of nature to cause death.

"The medical evidence clearly established that they were. The defence of provocation is also untenable. This was not a sudden loss of self-control, but a prolonged and repeated assault."

Duncan also dismissed a suggestion by the defence that Mohamad Nazmie Azzat might have survived if he had been given immediate medical attention, on the basis that expert testimonies did not confirm this as a certainty, but only a possibility.

"The fifth prosecution witness, Dr Dzureena Abdul Multalib, did acknowledge during cross-examination that survival was a possibility, if the deceased had received timely and aggressive medical treatment.

"Her evidence as a pathologist, in my view,

went no further than suggesting a possibility, not a probability and certainty. For these reasons, the court finds that the fatal assault was the product of a shared common intention and the defences advanced are without merit."

The prosecution team comprised DPPs Nur Nisla Abdul Latif, Ng Juhn Tao and Batrisyia Mohd Khusri.

Eight of the 13 teenagers were represented by lawyers Datuk Ram Singh, Kamarudin Mohamad Chinki and Chen Wen Jye, while the other five were represented by lawyers Mohamed Zairi Zainal Abidin, Abdul Ghani Zelika, Vivian Thien, Jhesseny P. Kang and Kusni Ambotuwu.

On Feb 28, Duncan ordered the 13 teenagers to enter their defence on the charge of murdering Mohamad Nazmie Azzat in the dormitory rooms 7 Resak and 5 Belian at the Lahad Datu Vocational College, between 9pm on March 21 and 7.38am on March 22, 2024.

They were charged under Section 302 of the Penal Code for murder, read together with Section 34 of the same Code, which carries the death penalty, or up to 40 years' imprisonment and not more than 12 strokes of the cane.

The defence proceedings began on March 10, with 18 witnesses, including all 13 accused, called to testify.

The prosecution opened its case on Nov 19, 2024, calling 25 witnesses.

Mengikut pertuduhan, semua remaja itu dituduh bersama membunuh Mohamad Nazmie, 17 tahun, di bilik asrama Kolej Vokasional Lahad Datu pada pukul 9.00 malam, 21 Mac hingga pukul 7.38 pagi 22 Mac 2024.

Nazmie ditemukan tidak sedarkan diri di atas katil di bilik asrama kolej berkenaan sebelum disahkan meninggal dunia.
